Dear Sir/Maam,

Please refer to this Department's letter of even no. dated 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2019 regarding issuing of appropriate instructions to all schools in your State/UT to avoid usage of single-use plastic, both within and outside the school premises.

- 2. Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation vide letter No.2/2/S(DWS)/19 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2019 (copy enclosed) has inter alia requested this Department for participation of school students in <u>shramdaan on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 and 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019</u>.
- 3. The Swachhata Hi Seva 2019 will commence on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 and mass awareness generation activities for plastic waste management will be carried out across the country till 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2019. On 2<sup>nd</sup> October, Swachh Bharat Diwas, a special national shramdaan for plastic waste collection will be organized in all villages and towns across the country. From 3<sup>rd</sup> October till 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 (Diwali), the collected plastic waste will then be effectively recycled and disposed. The campaign will run as per following timeline.

11 <sup>th</sup> September, 2019 to 1 <sup>st</sup> October, 2019	<ul> <li>Mass Awareness Generation Activities for plastic waste management</li> <li>Preparations for collection, disposal of plastic waste</li> <li>Shramdaan for general swachhata</li> </ul>
2 <sup>nd</sup> October, 2019	Nationwide shramdaan for plastic waste collection.
3 <sup>rd</sup> October to 27 <sup>th</sup> October, 2019	Recycling, effective disposal of collected plastic waste.

4. This Department's letter No. 27-6/2019-IS-9 dated 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 may also be referred to wherein the action plan indicates activities relating to shramdaan on Swachhata Hi Seva Day i.e. 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. It is therefore, requested that necessary instructions may be issued to all schools in your State/UT for shramdaan activities on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 and 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019 under Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) 2019 by the school students of class VI-VIII and class IX-XII on similar lines as indicated in the action plan.



5. It is also requested to share with this Department the action taken on plastic waste free campaign in all schools in your State/UT.

The Swachh Bharat Mission has become a jan andolan under the leadership of the Prime Minister. To further intensify this jan andolan, the Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) campaign has been celebrated annually since 2017 in the weeks running up to Gandhi Jayanti. This campaign has mobilized crores of people every year, including political leaders, government officials, sports person, actors, faith leaders, corporates, children and the common people to triggering behaviour Thange on cleanliness, generate awareness for access to safe sanitation and toilets usage, and offer shramdaan for swachhata at public places.

During his Independence Day speech on 15th August 2019, the Prime Minister made another call to the nation, to work towards ridding our country from plastic waste. Hence, the theme of this year's SHS is Plastic Waste Management. The SHS 2019 will commence on 11th September, and mass awareness generation activities for plastic waste management will be carried out across the country till 1st October. On 2nd October, Swachh Bharat Diwas, a special national shramdaan for plastic waste collection will be organized in all villages and towns across the country. From 3rd October till 27th October (Diwali), the collected plastic waste will then be effectively recycled and disposed. A presentation in this regard was also made before the Council of Ministers.

As was discussed during the presentation, the Department of School Education and Literacy is requested to, apart from other things, take necessary action to ensure the following:

Issue an advisory to ban of single use plastics from all schools (i)

School students to do shramdaan on 11th September and 2nd October (ii)

Kendriya/Navodaya Vidyalayas to adopt a neighbouring village to make it plastic free 3 (iii)

4. Look forward to your support to make this campaign a success.
